International Student Scholarship Awards

This scholarship's purpose is to award outstanding international students in the Global Health Program and to promote learning. The qualification for students in the MS and Ph.D. program to receive this scholarship is a minimum GPA of 3.2 in the previous semester. In some special circumstances where the student cannot meet the GPA requirement for some reason, they can apply for their application to be reviewed by the Global Health Program faculty.

Students may apply for this scholarship along with their application to the program. Existing students should apply for this scholarship every semester when the application procedures are announced.

The Global Health Program reviews the application submitted by students and decides the amount to be awarded to each student. The scholarship amount covers either full or partial tuition and fees. The amount of the scholarship given each year will be adjusted annually based on the current budget, financial revenue, and number of international students accepted.

This scholarship is to be used as a tuition waiver/assistance. The sources of funding for these scholarships come from the Office of International Affairs, the Ministry of Education, or related funding from the College of Public Health.

Scholarships are only valid for the time frame specified in the award letter and cannot be deferred, except in special cases as decided by the Global Health Program faculty. In the event that a student withdraws from school, suspends their studies, or if the college decides to discontinue the student's grant for academic or disciplinary reasons before graduation, scholarship recipients must return their refunded tuition to the Global Health Program.
